

"Christ became obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name."

~ Philippians 2:8-11 ~

JESUS

is the name above every other name!

"JESUS" does not convey an idea that everyone can interpret as they wish. It's someone's name. And that someone taught, suffered, died, rose from the dead, ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father to judge the living and the dead.

There is raw power in the name JESUS. It makes polite company cringe. It sometimes divides families. It can float across the dinner table, letting everyone know exactly where you stand.

If you use it with reverence and conviction, people will realize you believe in JESUS. If it is used to swear, people will conclude you don't give a damn.

To my knowledge, no other people of faith use the name of their God in vain. Jews do not say Yahweh when they stub their toe. Muslims do not say Allah to tell someone off. Buddhists don't say Buddha to share a whopper story.

Christians who use the name of JESUS in vain should be ashamed of themselves, have a change of heart, and build their vocabulary. Truly, all of us need to be more careful to use the name of JESUS only when we are talking to Him or about Him with respect.

Nor should we settle. A comfortable, vague euphemism like "the man upstairs" or "the big guy" just won't do. We must not be afraid to use the name of JESUS with reverence and conviction. We ought to say JESUS with great love in our hearts, without any sense of cowardice.

Rather, let's bend our knees. Let's be like God and exalt the name of JESUS above every other name!




